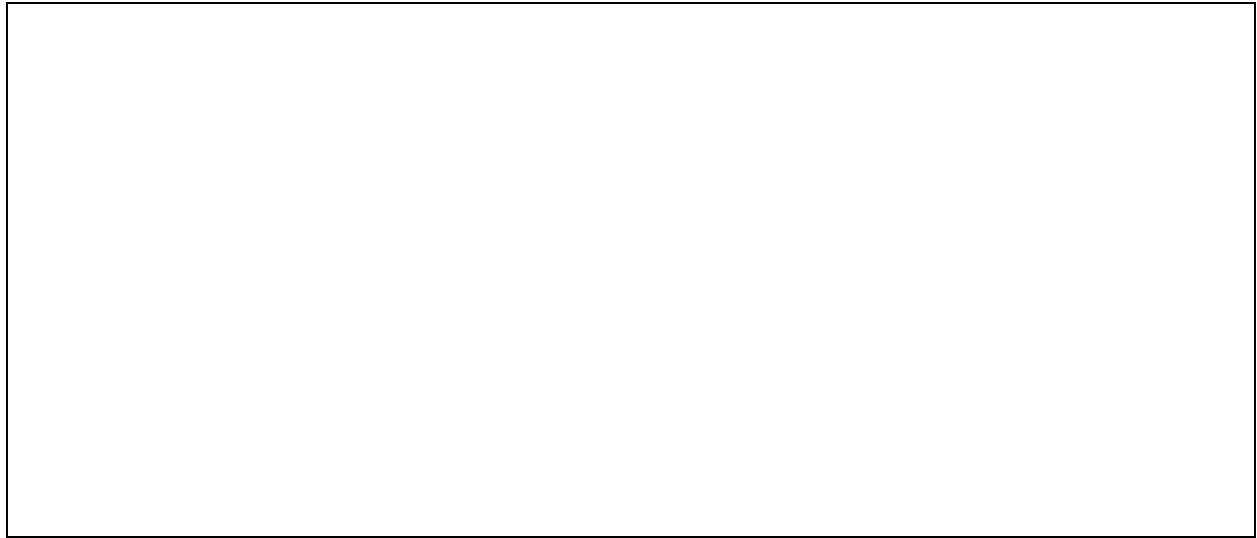

Date: April 19, 1775




Summary 3-5 sentences:
